Education Courses

These courses provide professional learning for K-12 teachers, instructional assistants, counselors, and administrators that are seeking re-certification and/or professional development. These online courses provide instruction at a pace that fits your schedule while you earn college credits.

EDF 1005- Introduction to Education (3 crs.)

This course covers the principles of education, placing emphasis on the philosophical, social, and historical essentials shaping the public education system in the United States. Students will explore different educational philosophies and their implications.

EDF 1030- Classroom Management (3crs.)

This course provides basic skills of classroom discipline designed to equip the educators with strategies for managing the learners, the environment and academic tasks, so that all pupils' opportunities for psychological and cognitive growth are enhanced.

EDF 2085- Teaching Diverse Population (3 crs.)

This course will explore the issues of diversity in our student population. It will focus on both theory and practical knowledge.
